With a program recommended by the Illinois State Board of Education and implemented by certified, experienced and loving teachers, the Helping Hands Preschool delivers a pre-kindergarten experience that is unmatched in Deerfield. The unique program is operated under the supervision and staff of District 109 with consultation services from Northern Suburban Special Education District (NSSD).

Helping Hands focuses on preparing children to succeed in the District 109 kindergarten curriculum. The program is designed to support the social, pre-academic, motor and language development of each child.

Morning classes serve three year olds,

afternoon classes are intended for four year olds. Class sizes are limited to approximately fourteen children with a blend of typically developed community peers and children with special needs. All children registering as community peers will be required to participate in a brief screening in order to qualify for the program.

Similar Programs in neighboring districts and current research have shown that shared learning experiences with highly trained educators, teaming to deliver pre-kindergarten academic and social skills, have a positive effect on both children with and without special needs. The Helping Hands program is based on best practices in early childhood education.
